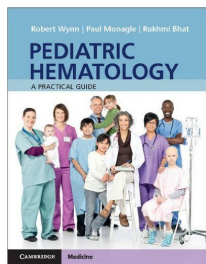


**PEDIATRIC HEMATOLOGY, A practical guide**
